## **SUMMARY OF THE CURRICULUM**

Degree in Psychology from the University of Deusto in 1997. Master in Mental Health from the University of Deusto and Master in cognitive Neuropsychology from the Universidad Complutense de Madrid. I completed my period of Internal Psychologist Resident at the Clinical Hospital San Carlos in Madrid between 1999 and 2002. Later I combined the clinical work in several areas (child and adolescent, adult mental health, first episodes of psychosis) in the Cantabrian Health Service with research activity in the Hospital Marqués de Valdecilla and the University of Cantabria. Phd in the University of Cantabria in the year 2008 with the qualification of outstanding cum laude. Later on I obtained the extraordinary prize of doctorate. Co-director of a doctoral thesis and author in more than forty articles indexed, interventions in national and international congresses, and book chapters, reaching an h-index of 20. Researcher CIBERSAM, I have collaborated as a researcher in several research projects funded after public competitive calls. Since 2011 I work in the Mental Health Network of Bizkaia in the Lehenak program. It is a clinical and research program aimed at providing early attention to first psychotic episodes. In addition I also collaborate in the coordination tasks of the research area of this network. Finally since 2008 I work as a tutor teacher at the Spanish open university (UNED), teaching various subjects as well as summer courses
